9:00 – 10:00	Opening Plenary – <i>Meeting People Fully: Psychosocial Rehabilitation–Guided HIV Outreach and Care Through The Program to Access Treatment for HIV and Support (PATHS)</i> Speakers: Jocelyn Bevacqua, NP and Zacharie Pagan, BSW RSW • PATHS is an outreach-based model designed for people living with HIV who are not effectively reached by existing HIV care systems in Manitoba • Grounded in psychosocial rehabilitation (PSR), PATHS delivers intensive case management and wrap-around supports through interdisciplinary teams that provide “in-the-moment” care across community and system settings • This session pairs a model and data-focused overview with a clinical perspective from the PATHS Nurse Practitioner, demonstrating how mental health, addictions, and HIV care are integrated in daily outreach practice to support improved outcomes • Together, the speakers will highlight lessons learned and implications for scaling whole-person HIV outreach in high-incidence settings
